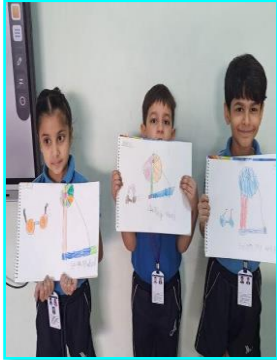
### ***Let's Sort***

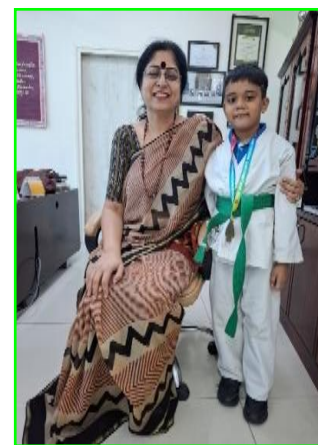
## **Skating Triumph**

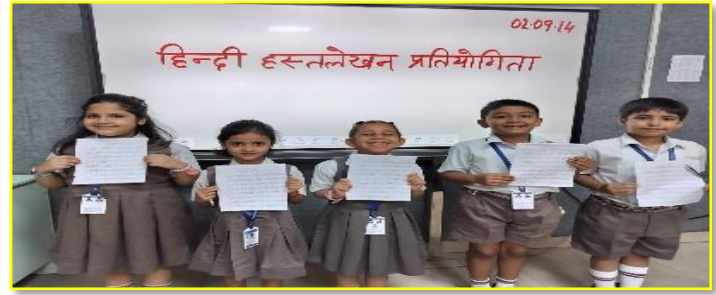
### ***Bites - A Palate fest***
