
STELLAR PERFORMANCES IN SOF OLYMPIADS

Jigyasa 2024: Exploring India's Diversity Through Knowledge





INNOVATIVE TEACHING PEDAGOGIES

At Mayoor School, Noida, we believe that teaching effective begins understanding our students' learning needs.



We aim to develop their ability to think analytically, make connections between ideas. and draw evidence-based conclusions.



In the recent activity conducted in Class X, the students explored Basic Proportionality Theorem through art integrated project. Using chart papers, they cut and pasted different triangles onto a parallel line plane to verify the theorem. This tactile experience not only made the learning process more but also deepened their engaging comprehension of the theorem.
