This initiative not only enhanced academic learning but also promoted cultural dialogue and mutual respect, strengthening ties between India and Germany.




STEAM EXHIBITION

Mental Health Matters: Insights from Wellness Unplugged








The Inter-House Badminton Competition for girls concluded with exciting matches, highlighting the skills and teamwork of the participants.

Sustainable Tech Takes Center Stage: A Celebration of Creativity and Environmental Awareness



INNOVATIVE TEACHING PEDAGOGY

In today's rapidly evolving educational landscape, encouraging student engagement and critical thinking is paramount. We, at Mayoor, have embraced innovative teaching pedagogies that not only captivate young minds but also empower them to connect theoretical concepts with real-world applications.



The topic of minerals and their conservation was brought to life through hands-on activities and visual aids focused on the 5R conservation strategies: Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Repurpose, and Recycle. Students engaged in practical exercises that deepened their understanding of and its resource management environmental implications.

INNOVATIVE TEACHING PEDAGOGY





Learners engaged in a hands-on lab session exploring the properties of acetic acid. They observed its distinctive vinegar-like odour and its reaction with litmus paper. The experiment demonstrated key concepts about acids through interactive learning, allowing students to connect theoretical knowledge with practical application.





An innovative approach was adopted in teaching Julius Caesar to Class X students through multimedia screenings. This dynamic pedagogy involved "Building, Creating, and Celebrating Content," enabling students to engage deeply with the historical context of the play and connecting themes of ambition and betrayal to contemporary issues, fostering critical thinking and a lasting appreciation for classical literature.
